ACTIVITIES OF THE TULUVA VELLALA ASSOCIATION

- (1) Scholarships for poor student's Education awarded every year since 1939. Poor students studying from class X to P.G. level are awarded scholarship out of the Educational Endowments received from the members and also from the Association's fund.
- (2) Giving old age destitute women monthly pension.
- (3) Poor parents are financially assisted to perform their daughter's marriages.
- (4) Arranging feeding of inmates of homes during auspicious occasions.
- (5) Offering Buttermilk to the devotees on the Arupathu Moovar festival.
- (6) Awareness Meeting.
- (7) Free Medical camp will be conducted on 15th August every year.
- (8) Matrimonial Information centre where people register the names of their wards and seek for suitable partners.
- (9) Distributing sewing machine to young needy women to sustain their livelihood.
- (10) Cash Award to those who obtain highest Marks in 10th Standard & Higher Secondary Examinations for our Member's Wards.
- (11) Those who are performing their Son's & Daughter's Marriage at "Nalvazhvu" were given concession of Rs. 5,000 & Rs. 10,000/- for our Community people.
